Are Cambridge and AICE the same thing?

Yes, AICE stands for Advanced International Certificate of Education. Cambridge is the program and AICE is the name given to the exams and diploma.

Please explain further about the 3 year rule for exams to count toward the AICE Diploma and why are 9th graders encouraged to take it?

Many schools in the State of Florida have students take General Paper as 9th graders. We decided to try it because so many students want to earn their AICE diploma by the end of their Junior year. Many students can earn their AICE diploma in two years, so by starting in 9th grade they had the opportunity finish in three years, before Senior year. We had about 90% of the students pass the exam, so many Freshman will be able to earn the AICE Diploma in those three years. If a student takes more than three years, any 9th grade scores will drop off. If a student is short by Senior year, they can opt to retake the General Paper exam.

When will PSAT results be released?

Florida scores will be released on December 13. This next line is from the College Board. If a student did not provide a legible and/or valid email address, the printed results will be at the school, sometime after Winter Break.

When should a student start taking the SAT and/ACT?

Students should start Junior year. No later than second semester of Junior year. They could delay acceptance, if they need to keep retaking the exams Senior year.
